Bridges to Hope has a warehouse with essential items necessary to set up a home after release from incarceration. Reentrants may shop at no cost to them for the following:

- ♦ Men's & Women's Clothes
- ♦ Furniture
- ♦ Household Items
- ♦ Bedding
- ♦ Kitchen Items
- ♦ Hygiene Products

We do this in hopes that it will alleviate some of the pressures they face as they try and begin a new life free from crime.
